This letter is to provide you with information regarding registration and other important reminders for our upcoming school year. Registration

We have worked hard to make our registration process as effective as possible. While many schools are opting to move registration online in order to save time and resources, we feel strongly that you will have a better experience in person. We have found that the energy and excitement families bring with them on these days sets a tone for the school year. For this reason, I would ask that you come with plenty of time to tour the school and interact with school employees, PFCC (parent club) members, and friends from the community.

The registration schedule is as follows:

Monday, August 17	Seniors-----1:00 -3:00 P.M.
Tuesday August 18	Juniors-----8:00-11:00 A.M.
Tuesday, August 18	Sophomores---12:00-3:00 P.M.
Wednesday, August 19	Freshmen-----10:00-1:00 P.M.

Student Success
