**1. Welcome:** The Cedar High Community Council convened in the large conference room on Tuesday, March 6, 2018. Principal Dodds called the meeting to order at 2:55pm.

**2. Action Items:**

a) Minutes from the January 9, 2018 council meeting were reviewed and a motion for approval was made by John Allred. Seconded by Kara Allred. Motion was carried and passed unanimously.

b) Principal Dodds reviewed with council members the current years budget and expenditures.

**3. Informational/Discussion Areas:**

a) Council members discussed the School Improvement Plan and reviewed each goal to come up with a proposed budget for the 2018-19 school year.

**The following budget items were proposed:**

- **Technology/Access to Computers - \$40,000.00**  
Council members discussed the value of one to one ratio vs classroom sets of chromebooks, with a possibility of rentals for those interested. It was decided that classroom sets would be a first priority at this time.
- **Learning Center - \$20,000.00**  
Council members discussed the after school hours and the possibility of adding a writing lab aide to help with language arts writing/composition.
- **Learning Strategies - \$30,000.00**  
Council members discussed the effectiveness of the program, as well as class sizes and the possibility of having four aides.
- **ACT Prep Class - \$5,600.00**  
Participation and student involvement of this program have been fantastic! Council suggested the possibility of students paying for the class.
- **Staff Developers - \$25,000.00**  
Council agreed upon the importance of keeping department chairs/coaches for the core classes Math, Science & English.
- **Professional Development vs Hall Monitor - \$TBD**

Council members discussed the recent concern of school safety and the possibility of hiring a hall monitor. Further discussion will take place at the next schedule meeting.
